The purpose of this position is to organize and facilitate current, comprehensive and historic preservation planning activities, perform in-depth research and analysis of planning data, zoning and subdivision ordinance and text amendments, neighborhood plans and coordinate the site plan review process. This position requires discretion and judgment in matters related to work procedures and policies of the work unit.
