- Setting and managing the program to performance outcomes;
- Contributing to MnDOT's capital investment program.

**Types of Opportunities:** This summer, we will be filling planning internship positions related to:

- Aeronautics;

- Public Engagement and project selection;
- Transportation equity;
- Environmental trends;
- Risk and asset management;
- Pedestrian, Bicycle, and Transit planning.

**Program Logistics:** The MnDOT Planning Internship Program runs from May through August. This internship is available for up to a 12-week, full-time appointment with flexible start date and schedule. All 2018 internship positions pay \$18.66/hour.

**Minimum Requirements:** A bachelor's degree in Transportation, Urban Planning, Public Policy, Geography, Public Administration, or a similar field.
